ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Wedgworth Leadership Institute for Agriculture and Natural Resources (WLIANR) develops and refines leaders to ensure a strong and adaptable Florida agriculture and natural resources industry for generations to come. The program prepares leaders to assume greater responsibilities in their organizations, industries, and communities while building the skills and perspective needed to influence constructive change.

Participants gain a deeper understanding of social, economic, and political systems and how to work effectively within them, while also developing a stronger understanding of themselves, others, and the diverse communities they serve.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

WLIANR is designed for professionals who already hold leadership roles and are ready for the next level of impact. The experience strengthens both personal and professional leadership capacity through:

- Leadership development through self and peer understanding
- Strategic thinking and effective communication skills
- Analysis of complex issues impacting agriculture and natural resources
- State, national, and international networking
- Exposure to public policy, economic systems, and global perspectives
- Building strategic alliances across Florida's agriculture and natural resource sectors

Professionals working in agriculture, natural resources, and related industries who:

- Have demonstrated leadership experience
- Aspire to greater leadership responsibility at community, state, national, or international levels
- Are committed to leadership, service, and community impact



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- Be 25 years of age by May 15, 2026
- Be a Florida resident for at least one year
- Derive a significant portion of income from agriculture or natural resources
- Demonstrate leadership experience
- Commit to attending all sessions in person



PROGRAM COST

The total cost of the WLIANR experience is \$21,000 per participant. Through the support of alumni and industry partners, class members pay only \$7,000, ensuring access to a world-class leadership development experience.
